

## CHC30102 Certificate III in Aged Care Work

Example of a model training program for aged care work against vocational outcomes for Assistant in Nursing/ Personal Care Assistant/Nursing Assistant in an aged care residential facility.

This qualification has **9 compulsory** and 4 elective units that have been arranged into delivery clusters.
